

**CHIPPEWA TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
PUBLIC HEARING ON
CESSNA HOSPITALITY
CONDITIONAL USE
MARCH 21, 2012**

The Chippewa Township Board of Supervisors held a public hearing on Wednesday, March 21, 2012, beginning at 7:00 p.m. Present were Supervisors James Bouril, Chairman, Thomas Roberts and Nancy Lamey; Manager Mark Taylor; Code Officer Dawna Pella; Solicitor George Verlihay and Administrative Assistant Angie O'Dell.

Chairman Bouril brought the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Manager Taylor noted that the purpose of the hearing was on a Conditional Use application submitted by Cessna Hospitality Associates, LP to construct a microtel in the (S-G) Special Growth District. The property is located at the corner of Cessna Drive and Darlington Road on property owned by Beaver Count Airport Authority, Tax Parcel #57-122-019.000.

Court Stenographer Donna McMullen was present to record the proceedings.

There were no representatives from Cessna Hospitality Associates, LP. present. Engineer Jim Culler, Keith Bolland and Don Bolland and Attorney Rich Faltenovich were present to observe the proceedings.

Attorney Faltenovich had some questions about the size of the hotel and when it would be started. Manager Taylor responded that it would have 79 rooms, 30 of which would be available to students for extended stay. There would be a conference room, exercise room and breakfast area. Construction would begin as soon as it is approved.

Court Stenographer Donna McMullen will provide the township with a full legal transcript of the night's proceedings for public viewing in the near future.

With nothing further to come before the board, the public hearing was adjourned.
