

CHIPPEWA TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
PUBLIC HEARING ON
ORDINANCE NO. 243
AMENDMENT OF ZONING ORDINANCE
JUNE 20, 2012

The Chippewa Township Board of Supervisors held a public hearing on Wednesday, June 20, 2012, beginning at 7:00 p.m. Present were Supervisors James Bouril, Chairman, Thomas Roberts and Nancy Lamey; Code Officer Dawna Pella; Solicitor George Verlihay and Administrative Assistant Angie O'Dell. Manager Taylor was absent.

Chairman Bouril brought the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Bouril noted that the purpose of the hearing was on a proposed amendment of Section 702 of Chapter 27, Part VII of the Township Code of Ordinances. The amendment of this section is to add municipal and public service administrative offices as a conditional use in the R-3 Suburban Residential District.

Court Stenographer Carole Carland was present to record the proceedings.

There were no visitors to make comments or give testimony regarding this amendment. Solicitor Verlihay noted that the Chippewa Township Planning Commission reviewed this proposed ordinance at their May 15, 2012 meeting and voted to recommended approval.

Court Stenographer Carole Carland will provide the township with a full legal transcript of the night's proceedings for public viewing in the near future.

With nothing further to come before the board, the public hearing was adjourned.
