

**CHIPPEWA TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
PUBLIC HEARING
ON
SIGN ORDINANCE 246
MAY 15, 2013**

The Chippewa Township Board of Supervisors held a public hearing on Wednesday, May 15, 2013, at 7:15 p.m. Present were Supervisors James Bouril, Thomas Roberts and Nancy Lamey, Township Manager Mark Taylor, Code Officer Dawna Pella, Solicitor George Verlihay, and Administrative Assistant Cindy Clark.

Chairman James Bouril brought the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Bouril noted that the purpose of the public hearing was to hear comments regarding changing the ordinance pertaining to temporary signs. (246) He said it has been publicized. Attorney Verlihay said it has been advertised. Chairman Bouril said that the Board will listen to any comments or questions from visitors that pertain to changing the sign ordinance.

Court Stenographer Donna McMullen was present to record the proceedings.
