Dear Mr. Taylor:

This is a follow-up to your letter of June 25, 2018 requesting a multi-way stop study at the intersection of S.R. 4040 (37th Street Extension) at S.R. 4017 (Shenango Road) in the Township of Chippewa, Beaver County.

The Department has conducted an engineering and traffic study to determine if a multi-way stop is warranted. This study considered the vehicular volume, safe running speed, sight distance and geometrics of the intersection. Currently, S.R. 4017 (Shenango Road) is not stop controlled while the S.R. 4040 (37th Street Extension) approaches are. The results of the study show that a multi-way stop is warranted. The Department will install the appropriate signs at this intersection as soon as scheduling permits.
