AGENDA MEETING**

The Chippewa Township Board of Supervisors held their monthly Agenda Meeting on Wednesday, March 11, 2026 at 10 a.m. Present were Chairman Dan Woodske, Supervisor Bryan Wright, Supervisor Jim Bouril, Manager Mark Taylor, Recreation Director/Assistant Manager Lauren Doyle, Code Enforcement Officer Dawna Pella, and Administrative Assistant Cindy Clark.

Chairman Woodske brought the meeting to order.

VISITORS

Chief Hermick, Matt Steklachick, and Eric Chaffee attended.

MANAGER

Township Manager Mark Taylor had the following items for discussion or action:

1. Ordinance 271:

Mark Taylor said that he has already forwarded this ordinance #271 to the Beaver County Planning Commission for review. We should get their response soon. The Township Planning Commission met last night with this on their agenda, and they were happy to know that the Township is being proactive on this matter. Our Planning Commission recommended approval of the passage of this ordinance. He feels that the hearing will likely be held next month and it will be ready for a vote for adoption following the hearing.

2. Parking Lot Expansion at Sahli Park:

Manager Taylor said that Lauren Doyle spoke to him about adding additional parking at Sahli Park. He said there is usually sufficient parking on a day-to-day basis, but there are not enough spaces when there are fund-raisers, library happenings, camps, and other events at the park. He said our road crew will extend the parking area up toward the woods. Chairman Woodske asked if it will be gravel and Manager Taylor said it will be limestone, like is already there. Supervisor Wright asked how many additional parking spaces will be added, and Lauren said the area which now has around 12 spaces should at least double in size with this expansion.

3. Department Reports:

- A. Police:

- C. Recreation:
Written update submitted on March 10th. Lauren said that she opened up camp reservations last week and slots for most of the camps are already filled with wait lists. Easter events will take place on March 29th.
