AGENDA MEETING**

The Chippewa Township Board of Supervisors held their monthly Agenda Meeting on Wednesday, April 8, 2026 at 10 a.m. Present were Chairman Woodske, Supervisor Jim Bouril, Manager Mark Taylor, Recreation Director/Assistant Manager Lauren Doyle, Code Enforcement Officer Dawna Pella and Administrative Assistant Cindy Clark.

Supervisor Bryan Wright did not attend.

Chairman Dan Woodske brought the meeting to order.

VISITORS

Eric Chaffee, Dorinda Roberts, Matt Steklachick, Annette Ice, and Eli Kosanovich attended.

MANAGER

Township Manager Mark Taylor had the following items for discussion or action:

1. Hearing Notice for Ordinance #271:

Manager Taylor had provided the Supervisors with a copy of the notice/legal ad for the hearing on Ordinance #271. The hearing time for next Wednesday night is listed as 6:30, at the beginning of the Regular Meeting. He said it will be up to the Supervisors to decide if they want to adopt this after the hearing.

2. MS4 Update:

Manager Taylor said he has met with one group so far. That meeting was with the residents of Timberwood who were concerned, as they have a few ponds. They were told to come to the Township with a plan. He felt it was a good discussion. Manager Taylor said they can put together a 2-year-program to fix the ponds. Residents from Shenango Woods have also responded. He said they are pursuing this slowly.

3. 2026 Road Program:

A list of roads to be done is being compiled. Manager Taylor told the Supervisors to submit any questions or requests regarding the roads to him or to Eric Chaffee. He said that the list should be prepared by next month's meeting.

4. Job Description for Street Department Position:

Manager Taylor had provided the Supervisors with a copy of the job description for the street department position. He said that prior to any other type of advertising, this will be posted on the Township web site, in the Township newsletter, and on our Facebook site.
